PRESCHOOL PROCEDURES AND POLICIES:



ARRIVAL AND PICK-UP:

When the garage door is open, it means preschool is open for the day and students may enter; the door usually will open at 9:20am (ten minutes prior to the beginning of class). Please bring students on time. Prompt arrival helps all students have the most learning time. For safety reasons, the door will close and lock at 9:40am. If you need to enter after this time, please call or text Ms. Suzy.

The door opens again when preschool is finished for the day and we are ready for student pick up. Preschool ends at 12:00 noon. Please be prompt when picking up your child.

If your child is picked up more than 15 minutes late, you will incur a \$5 late- pickup fee. The fee increases \$1/minute after 12:15pm. The charges will be added to the following month's tuition.

ILLNESS:

Do not send your child to school if:

- Fever is greater than 100.5
- Vomiting
- Stiff neck or headache and fever
- Pinkeye (tears, redness of eye or eyelid, swelling and discharge)
- New on-set of rash with concurrent or proceeding fever
- Jaundice
- Persistent diarrhea
- Excessive coughing or runny nose

When children have any of the above symptoms, they should not come to school. If children have had a fever of 100.5 or over, wait until your child is fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school. Lingering congestion, cough and tiredness may still be serious enough to prevent your child from engaging in learning activities. If you are not sure whether your child should come to school, air on the side of caution.

CONTAGIOUS ILLNESSES:

If your child has any contagious condition (strep throat, pink eye, chicken pox, lice, etc.) please contact Ms. Suzy immediately. With any contagious condition, your child cannot return to school until they are symptom and contagious free for a minimum of 24 hours.

TUITION:

Monthly tuition is due on the first school day of each month. Tuition may be paid in cash, check or via Paypal. The late tuition fee is \$5 if paid within the first week of the month and increases by \$5 for every additional week late.

SCHOOL CLOTHING:

Please keep in mind when choosing the clothes your child will wear that we use glue, paint, shaving cream and other things that may stain your child's clothing. We're not messy, we're creative! Clothing should be comfortable and practical for play. Gross motor skills are part of our curriculum; therefore, clothing should allow your child to move comfortably and freely.

SNACKS:

Snack time is not only to feed our bodies, but it gives students time to socialize with peers and the teacher, practice manners, life skills, communication and more! Signing up to help with snacks is not a requirement but welcomed as a way to volunteer. If you sign up to help with snack, please bring enough for 8 peers, and please choose something healthy. Please avoid bringing cookies or sweet snacks unless it is for a birthday celebration.

Ms. Suzy always has fresh fruit or vegetables available as a snack on days that are not assigned to a volunteer, but any help is very appreciated!

A few suggestions for snack time are:

- Crackers with cheese
- Dried fruit
- Celery and Peanut Butter (unless we are notified of any peanut allergy)
- Chopped vegetables (cucumber, bell pepper, etc)
- Pretzels
- Mini-sandwiches
- Raisins
- Mini-carrots and hummus
- String cheese
- Fresh fruit or fruit cups
- Graham crackers
- Yogurt
- Dry cereal (non-sugared)
- Chips and salsa

ABSENCES:

If it is possible, please text or call Ms. Suzy to let her know when your child will not be in attendance.

CALENDAR/HOLIDAYS:

Xiao Panda Preschool follows the Alpine School District Calendar. If Alpine District is closed, we are closed; our holiday schedule follows that of the school district. The only difference is the school start date: we will begin September 4th.
